V. VICE CHAIRMAN’S REPORT:

The Marshal’s Report – June 14, 2016 through July 12, 2016.

Chairman Escapule; “Marshal the floor is all yours.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “Thank you Mr. Mayor. Last month; I am not going to go over everything. I am just going to highlight. We had six agency assist. We had two alarm calls that we responded to. We had two alcohol offenses, eleven animal problems of one sort or another. We investigated two assaults, one burglary, eight citizen assist, we had seven disorderly conduct charges, four drug arrest, two DUI arrests. We had four fires that we responded to. Lots of found property, four fraud cases that investigated. Twenty

two information calls, twenty medical calls that the guys rolled on. Four parking problems, one sexual conduct offense we investigated. We only conducted one search warrant this month. Ten suspicious calls, two theft calls. We had an automobile theft recently which turned into a false reporting arrest. Six traffic hazards, one hundred and twenty four traffic stops with thirty four citations. Mr. Lohse is settling down a little bit and two wanted warrants that we arrested and eight welfare checks.”

“On top of that I went to a conference last week in Phoenix to the GOHS Conference. I met with the director Roberto Gutierre. I asked him if he received my grant and if they had made a decision. He assured me that we would get some overtime money. I asked for quite a bit and I think he said that I would probably get about three thousand dollars’ worth of overtime but he did surprise me when he said what kind of car do you want? So he led me to believe that in the September October time frame he’ll award us with a DUI car which will be an unmarked SUV similar to what we are buying. That was good news.”

“I am still waiting on the results of two other grants that I have submitted. One was through Stonegarden. I have asked for a hundred and (inaudible) worth of equipment but I am more optimistic with the Tohono O’odham grant that I applied for which is body cameras and cameras for the vehicles and radar equipment. So hopefully that will be an affirmative.”

“I have training scheduled; well it was scheduled for the ninetieth on Arizona Traffic Accident Investigation. That is going to be mandatory to all the deputies. I also have mandatory in service training at Sierra Vista PD on the use of force. In October will be the bi annual update training. So that they will have all the new laws that come into effect after the last session.”

“We are still at full strength however; two deputies are in testing process with other agencies. We have three active reserves and I have an application for a fourth.”

“Our Reserves this month have log thirty two point five hours for the month of June contributing roughly five hundred and sixty dollars that would normally be paid to a deputy.”

“I would like to thank the Mayor and Council for all the support given to the Marshal’s Office so far this year. Without the support of our administration we could not have achieved where we are today. We are being viewed by outside agencies differently. Our equipment has improved significantly and more importantly moral has increased which equates to (inaudible) retention. I am especially thankful to the Mayor and Council for allowing the Marshal’s Office to create and promote the position of sergeant and corporal.”

“This concludes my report!”

There being no further questions Mayor Escapule closes discussion.
