V. VICE CHAIRMAN’S REPORT:

The Marshal’s Report – August 9, 2016 through September 13, 2016.

Chairman Escapule; “Marshal the floor is yours.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “Not much has happened this past month except us getting our cars finally. Everybody is kind of excited about that.

Vice Chairman Randall; “for the month we had three agency assists, nine alarms that we responded to, six animal problems. We had three assaults that we investigated, seven citizens assist, two criminal damages, three dead bodies, one disturbance, three

domestic violence investigations, one drug arrest, three DUI arrests, three intoxicated subjects in public, three lost properties, we responded on nine medical calls. We only had one parking problem. We arrest four drivers on suspended license. We had twelve suspicious in nature calls, two theft calls, one threatening call, we only made a hundred and twenty two traffic stops, with forty three citations, leaving about 80 and some odd warnings, two trespassing calls and one unsecured premises.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “As I states we received all the vehicles. They are all on the road now. We are still getting some of the bugs worked out of it. I personally think that they hurried to much to put the vehicles together. Some of them are still needing some stuff; such as mine. So we are getting that squared away.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “Scheduled training; Deputy Robinson & Blackmer are attending general instruction class in Phoenix today through the rest of the week. We have rifle training with Sierra Vista PD on September 22, 2016 and October 12th, we have legal updates at the Sierra Vista Police Department.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “We are still at full strength with three active reserves and have an application for a forth. Our reserves have logged fifty one point five hours for the month of August. Contributing nine hundred dollars that would normally be paid a deputy. Speaking of our reserves; since we got the new cars I have kept two cars for back up and I have semi assigned them to the reserves and they have taken so much pride in the fact that they are working for the Tombstone Marshals Office that one of the reserves has probably spent well over two hundred dollars getting the car detailed, polished, all the lights, all the faded paint and plexi -glass and all that sort of thing taken care of. Just so he will have it for work when he comes in for Tombstone. You have a good crew as for as reserves are concerned.”

Vice Chairman Randall; “That’s about all I’ve got.”

Chairman Escapule; “I just want to talk briefly about the Marshal’s Office. This is just tentative as far as the construction. The publication for the bids will go out on October 10th, Pre-bid meeting on October 26, 2016 and the next would be notice of awarding the bids on November 21st and the notice of proceed on December 6th. We are moving forward. I think the estimated completion date for this phase of the project is sometime in July.”

Chairman Escapule; “Any questions for the Marshal?”

There being no further questions Chairman moves forward to adjournment.
